- SEEN the communication with which the University has expressed, pursuant to Article 8, c. 1, of Ministerial Decree 630/2024, its interest in participating in the procedure referred to in the aforementioned decree as Implementing Party;
- SEEN the letters of commitment signed with financing institutions or companies to guarantee the co-financing of the Doctoral grants for which the aforementioned co-financing is envisaged;
- CONSIDERED the obligations on the implementing entities of NRRP - funded interventions to ensure that doctoral students can make use of qualified and specific operational and scientific facilities for study and research activities; to foster, while respecting intellectual property, the exploitation of research results through adequate circulation of the results pursued, in any case in accordance with the "Open Science" and "FAIR Data" principles; to comply with the

"do no significant harm" (DNSH) principle pursuant to Art. 17 of Regulation (EU) 2020/852 in accordance with the technical guidelines prepared by the European Commission (European Commission Communication 2021/C58/01); to provide appropriate procedures to address and redress gender inequalities and to support the participation of women and young people;

TAKEN NOTE that the aforementioned funding from the NRRP resources will cover the three-year period of the grants assigned with this Note of Competition and that the University, for the remaining expenses, will meet with its own resources

SEEN the resolutions of the Academic Senate and the Board of Directors with resolution of July 29th 2024.

SUBJECT TO RESERVATION for any amendments, updates or integrations to the present notice of competition that will be communicated, exclusively, by publication on the website;

CONSIDERED that, in case of performance of the competition exams, the opened positions and study grants will be assigned to the applicants who will suitably be ranked in the list only following the accreditation by the MIUR as per the Min. Decree n° 226/2021. Failing the accreditation the exams will be automatically be rendered null and void;

HEREBY DECREES

ART. 1 – ESTABLISHMENT

The 40th cycle – 2024/2025 Acad. Year for Research Doctorates is established. A public competition is issued for exams for admission to the following Courses of Research Doctorate:

- Engineering of Technological Innovation;
- Mind and Technologies in the Digital Society;

The enclosed Doctorate Sheets, that must be considered as an integral part of the present notice, contain, for each Doctorate's courses, information regarding the number of positions envisaged for this competition, the number of study grants, envisaged for this competition, the assessment criteria of any titles, the dates on which the admission exams will take place, languages and any other modes of performing the selections.

The number of the positions with a study grant may be increased further to additional funding or agreements with external, public or private Boards.

ART. 2 – AVAILABLE POSITIONS

The positions opened by the competition can be found within the individual Information Sheets for each Doctoral Program and can be divided into:

- ordinary positions with grants, including those linked to specific projects/themes;
- positions with grants financed on Next Generation EU - NRRP funds ex Min. Decree 630/2024;
- ordinary positions without grants.

ART. 3 – ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Those who upon the expiry of this notice possess a university degree (*laurea*) (as per previous regulations) or specializing (*specialistica*) and/or a master-level (*magistrale*) degree (as per new regulations), mentioned in the Doctorate Sheet or a similar academic title earned abroad and previously recognized as equivalent by the Coordinator of the doctorate course, having sought the advice of the Professors' Board or in the framework of inter-university cooperation and mobility agreements, for the exclusive purpose of the admission to the Doctorate course, can access the research doctorate, with no age and citizenship limitations. Those possessing a title, required to be admitted, awarded no later than the 31st October of the same year, can submit an application for the positions with study grants, under penalty of not being admitted even if they passed the selection procedure.

Simultaneous enrollment in a Research Doctorate and in an undergraduate or master's degree program is

allowed according to the provisions of Ministerial Decree N° 930 of 29-07-2022.

ART. 4 – ADMISSION APPLICATIONS

The participation application must be submitted, under penalty of exclusion, not later than the mandatory term of the 10th September 2024, at 23:59.

The applicant must make the **Registration** of his personal data via the link:

Once this first step is completed, a **user name** will be issued by the system while the **password** will be created by the applicant himself. The applicant must then log in with his credentials at the following link

Having logged in, he will have to go to **Secretariat** and then to the **Admission Exam** heading following the procedure.

The applicant is required to upload the required attachments in the procedure indicated when filling out the application.

Upon completion of the procedure, the applicant must print out the application signed and attach it in the appropriate box (**Application for Admission**), and must then proceed to the payment of a fee for procedural expenses, without the right to reimbursement in case of non-participation for any reason, amounting to € 60.00 (sixty/00 euros), with appropriate PgoPA Bulletin.

Incomplete applications and applications that, for whatever reason, are found to have been forwarded to this University after the deadline referred to in this article will not be considered.

The statements made in the application are deemed to be made in accordance with Presidential Decree N° 445 of 28.12.2000, published in the Ordinary Supplement to the Gazzetta Ufficiale N° 42 of 20.02.2001, as amended, by applicants entitled to use the forms of simplification of administrative certifications permitted by the aforementioned decree.

The applicants must submit, jointly with the application the following documents:

- **curriculum vitae** including authorization to process personal data for the purpose of this selection procedure (*mandatory*);
- photocopy of **tax code/health card** (*mandatory*);
- **study title** held, in accordance with the following forms (*mandatory*):
 - for applicants who earned their degree in Italy: title, in original or certified copy, or copy declared to be true to the original in accordance with Articles 19 and 47 of Presidential Decree N° 445 of December 28, 2000, in accordance with the attached Model C, or by means of a declaration instead of certification, made in accordance with Article 46 of Presidential Decree N° 445 of December 28, 2000, in accordance with the attached Model B, also indicating the final grade.
 - for applicants who have obtained their degree abroad, which has not yet been declared equivalent to one of the required Italian degrees: documents useful to enable the Commission to declare equivalence. Specifically: degree diploma, or certified copy, accompanied by official translation into Italian, legalized (where necessary). Subsequent to the tests, and within six months of matriculation, admitted candidates must also transmit, under penalty of forfeiture from the Doctoral Course, the declaration of value by the Italian diplomatic or consular representation with territorial jurisdiction in the country where the degree was obtained;
- any publications, in original or certified copy, or copy declared to be true to the original pursuant to Articles 19 and 47 of Presidential Decree N° 445 of December 28, 2000, in accordance with the attached Model C (available as an annex to this notice);
- any other titles in the original or certified copy, or copy declared to be a true copy of the original pursuant to Articles 19 and 47 Decree of the President of the Republic, December 28, 2000, N° 445, in accordance with the attached Model C, or by means of a declaration instead of certification, made pursuant to Article 46 of D.P.R. December 28, 2000, N° 445, in accordance with the attached Model B (available in annex to this notice);

- list on unstamped paper of any publications and titles submitted as an attachment to the application;
- detailed **research project** to be carried out during the three-year period, drawn up according to the attached form (*mandatory*);

In the application form, applicants with disabilities (pursuant to Law N°. 104 of February 5, 1992 and supplemented by Law N° 17 of January 28, 1999) or with Specific Learning Disorders - DSA (pursuant to Law N° 170 of October 8, 2010) must submit an explicit request regarding the necessary aid, as well as the possible need for additional time for the performance of the admission tests. It is specified that applicants with disabilities must attach appropriate medical certification issued by the competent health authorities through medical commissions. Candidates with Specific Learning Disorders must submit appropriate clinical certification, issued no more than three years ago by the National Health Service.

ART. 5 – ADMISSION APPLICATIONS OF THE APPLICANTS POSSESSING AN ACADEMIC TITLE EARNED ABROAD

Besides submitting the admission application with modes mentioned in art. 4 above, the applicants possessing an academic title earned abroad will have to imperatively transmit the following documentations no later than the fixed deadline:

- For applicants possessing a title earned in EU country
As per articles 46 and 47 of the Decree of the President of the Republic n°445/2000 and following amendments and integrations, self-certification of the degree title including a list of the exams and relative grades in Italian or in English.
- For applicants possessing a title earned in an NON-EU country
Degree certification including a list of the exams and relative grades, translated and legalized in Italian or in English.
- Form A/1 Request for Equivalence of Qualification (available as an annex to this Notice).

ART. 6 – EXAMS

In order to take the exams, the applicant will have to show a valid identity document.

The admission to the Doctorate Course is aimed at assuring a fair comparative assessment of the applicants and occurs based on public evidence selection meant to control the skills and the aptitudes of the applicant to scientific research in the fields pertaining to the Courses.

The methods for taking the exams specified on the web pages of each individual course and given in the attached doctoral forms are:

- 1) **First exam;**
- 2) **Titles assessment;**
- 3) **Oral exam.**

The oral exam may be carried on online, at the sole discretion of the Commission, exclusively for applicants with residence or domicile abroad.

The verification of the applicant's identity will be carried out by the Chairman of the Commission who will record the candidate's identification data, type and number of document and will verify the proper functioning of the work stations set up for online interview. This interview will take place on the day specified in the doctoral form. Applicants for the admission competitions for Research Doctorates for which, in this notice, the dates of the exams are specified, are required to show up on the day, time and in the manner established without waiting for further call.

ART. 7 – EVALUATION COMMISSIONS

The Evaluation Commissions of the competition for admission to the research doctorate courses are appointed in accordance with the Regulations as regards research doctorates.

However, for Doctorates structured on more curricula, a single competition must take place with a single

Commission. Separated competition exams are possible for each individual curriculum, further to a specific option made by the Evaluation Commission.

Once the competition exams are completed, the Commission prepares a general merit-ranking list based on the sum of the grades obtained by each applicant in the evaluation of the titles and in the individual exams. In case of parity, the following criteria will be applied:

- In case of grades parity resulting in a position covered by a grant the assessment of the financial situation prevails, defined as per the Decree of the President of the Council of the Ministers of 09/04/2001.
- In case of grades parity resulting in a position without grant a preference will be given to the applicants who:
 - a) Achieved a higher grade in their degree;
 - b) With equal degree grade, have a higher average grade in their exams;
 - c) With equal degree grade and exams average grade, have earned a degree in less time, having taken into account the course legal duration;
 - d) With equality of the elements specified in points 1, 2, 3 younger applicants will be preferred.

ART. 8 – ADMISSION TO THE COURSES

The applicants will be admitted to the courses based on their position in the ranking list up to covering the number of available positions

Those who have already earned a Research Doctor title can be admitted to attend, further to passing the selection exams, a second Doctorate course not covered by a grant for those who have already benefitted from it and provided that the issues and the main scientific-disciplinary sectors are unlike compared to those related to the course for which the title was earned.

ART. 9 – ENROLLEMENT TO THE COURSES AND ACCESS FEES AND ATTENDANCE

After checking the fair performance of the competition deeds, the relative ranking lists will be notified exclusively by publication on the University's Internet site, in the Calls and Competitions/Research Doctorates section.

The published ranking lists will include as well the modes and deadlines to finalize the enrolment, upon expiry of the set deadlines, the applicants who will have not performed what it is required, will be considered as renouncing and they will be replaced by another applicant based on the ranking list order.

Courses will begin on November 1, 2024. Admission to the doctoral program entails an exclusive, full-time commitment.

For non-EU doctoral students who require a visa to enter Italy, there is the possibility of starting the research activity remotely, subject to the positive opinion of the Coordinator of the doctoral course. This possibility is granted upon proof of submission of the visa application at the relevant Embassy or Consulate, to be made as soon as the application procedure is completed.

Arrival in Italy must take place no later than January 31, 2025, otherwise the applicant will be considered a dropout.

Doctorate students without a scholarship are also required to pay the annual application fee of 3,000.00 euros.

Enrollment in the academic years following the first is subject to positive evaluation by the College of Professors.

ART. 10 – STUDY GRANTS

The study grant yearly amount, established as per art. 1 of the Min. Decree n° 247/2022, amounts to **€ 16,243.00** before the security contribution at the recipient's expense.

The duration of the allocation of the study grant is equal to the entire course duration.

The study grant is paid on monthly basis. The amount is increased up to 50% for any authorized periods spent abroad for a maximum of 12 months, subject to the conditions established in Article 9 paragraph 3 of Ministerial Decree 226/2021. Each doctoral student is granted, within the limit of the available budget resources, a suitable budget for research activities in Italy and abroad based on the type of course and, in any case, of an amount not smaller than 10% of the grant. If the doctoral student, holding a grant, is not positively evaluated for the purposes of being admitted to the subsequent year and is, consequently, excluded from the doctorate or renounces to the grant, the non-used amount remains at the University's availability.

The personal income ceiling to be able to benefit from the study grant is **€ 8,500.00** yearly before tax. To the establishment of this income contribute incomes derived from properties as well as retributions of any other nature, including the occasional ones. The income is referred to the taxation period related to the calendar year of the larger enjoyment of the study grant.

The doctorate student, holding a grant, who overcomes this ceiling of personal income, will have to give back the instalments of the study grant received in the year of reference and pay the enrolment fees for doctorate students without grant for the current year to the University.

The cases of total or partial incompatibility to benefit from the study grant are established by regulations that are currently in force. In particular, as per the law n° 398/89 art.6, the study grants cannot be combined with other study grants, at any title awarded, excepting those awarded by national or foreign institutions useful to integrate educational or research activities of the grants holders by travels abroad.

The Doctorate study grants are incompatible, under penalty of revocation of its benefit and with the obligation to return the received installments, with: dependent employment, even on a temporary basis; industrial and commercial activities; any other activity requiring the holding of a V.A.T. number.

In case of occurred incompatibility, the study grant installments related to the period for which they were unduly received, must be returned. The repayment refers to the academic year or to a part of it.

Those who have already benefitted from a study grant cannot benefit from the same title twice.

Doctoral grants funded by the National Recovery and Resilience Plan ex Min. Decree 630/2024

The National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR- *Piano Nazionale di Ripresa e Resilienza*) under Mission 4 Component 2 Investment 3.3 has allocated resources for the activation of innovative doctoral pathways with the contribution and involvement of businesses. Ministerial Decree 630/2024 allocated resources to the University for the activation of doctoral fellowships co-funded by enterprises interested in meeting their research and innovation needs.

The University identifies enterprises to participate in the co-funding of the scholarships and selects research projects to be implemented as part of the doctoral courses accredited for the 40th cycle.

These projects, in accordance with the aforementioned Ministerial Decree 630/2024, must result in:

- a. consistent with the goals and objectives of Regulation (EU) 2021/241, the overall strategy and the NRRP Component Detail Sheet;
- b. geared towards the achievement of results measured by reference to milestones and targets that may be assigned to the Investment within the timeframe established by the Plan;
- c. compliant with the principle of "do no significant harm" (DNSH) under Article 17 of Regulation (EU) 2020/852 in accordance with the technical guidelines prepared by the European Commission (European Commission Communication 2021/C58/01);
- d. suitable for addressing and bridging gender inequalities;
- e. supporting the participation of women and young people, also consistent with the provisions of Decree-Law No. 77 of May 31, 2021 (so-called Simplification Decree), as amended by Conversion Law No. 108 of July 29, 2021, regarding the management of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP).

The research projects that are the recipients of doctoral grants under the initiative's Ministerial Decree 630/2024 must also:

- a. relate to disciplinary and thematic areas consistent with the needs of the Country, as well as the regional territories covered by the program, in terms of highly qualified profiles and oriented to meet the innovation needs of enterprises referred to in the NRRP;
- b. provide for the implementation of the entire course of doctoral studies, training, research and evaluation, at the administrative and operational offices of the Institutions without prejudice to the periods of study and research at the company and abroad, scheduled consistently with the training and research activities planned at the offices of the Implementing Party;
- c. provide for periods of study and research in the enterprise from a minimum of six (6) months to a maximum of eighteen (18) months, including non-continuous periods, within the three-year period;
- d. provide for periods of study and research abroad, including non-continuous, from a minimum of six (6) months up to the maximum limit provided for in Article 9, paragraph 3, of the Decree of the Minister of University and Research December 14, 2021, N° 226 and Article 8, paragraph 3, of the Decree of the Minister of University

and Research February 21, 2024, N° 470, over the three-year period

e. ensure that the doctoral student can make use of qualified and specific operational and scientific facilities, in accordance with the law, for study and research activities, including (if relevant to the type of course) scientific laboratories, libraries, databases, etc.; and

f. provide for the implementation of educational activities for language and computer training, for research management and knowledge of European and international research systems, for the exploitation of research results and intellectual property;

g. provide, by means of a letter of commitment and/or agreement, for the involvement of companies in the definition of the training course also within the framework of broader collaborations with the University and co-financing by the same companies for the amount exceeding the value of € 60,000.00 (sixty thousand/00) up to the total cost of the scholarship;

h. to encourage, while respecting intellectual property, the valorization of research results both within the activity of the co-financing enterprises, also in the perspective of technology transfer, and in the scientific sphere, through an adequate circulation of the results pursued, in any case according to the "Open science" and "FAIR Data" principles.

Following the matriculation of successful candidates following selection, the Ministry of University and Research (MUR) will verify the eligibility of the projects for the purposes of NRRP support, and ANVUR will verify consistency with the requirements of Ministerial Decree 630/2024. Once these verifications are completed, the MUR will announce the final allocation of the funding due to each university. Therefore, the admission to the doctoral program of the winners of former Ministerial Decree 630/2024 positions is to be considered under the condition of the positive verification of consistency and eligibility and the allocation of ministerial funding.

ART. 11 – DUTIES AND RIGHTS OF THE DOCTORATE STUDENTS

Those enrolled in the doctorate courses have an obligation to attend the courses and continuously carry on study and research activities in framework of the structures aimed at this end. The doctorate students are also required to account for the activities conducted by yearly filling in a special sheet.

The doctorate students carry on a tutoring activity for the students of the degree and master-level degree courses as well as a limited supplementary or integrative teaching activity that, in any case with no prejudice to the activity of learning to research within a maximum limit of 40 hours per each academic year. This activity must be authorized by the Committee of the Professors who established its modes. During the course the doctorate student can be authorized, for research needs, to make travels abroad for a period not longer than half of the course legal duration

This Committee, in case of insufficient results in the mid-term evaluation tests, in case of unjustified and lasting nonattendance or lasting non availability, that is if a doctorate student behaves in a way that is incompatible with research ethical conduct and with the rules of good conduct prescribed by the organizational structure where the Doctorate takes place as regards those, who at any title, benefits from its reception and from its services, can reasonably deliberate the revocation of doctorate student from the course.

The attendance to the doctorate course can be interrupted, further to a deliberation made by the Committee of the Professors, further to a deliberation of the Committee of the Professors, in the following cases: pregnancy, serious and documented illness, particular family situations and for other cases provided by law.

An extension of the duration of the doctoral course for a period not exceeding twelve months may, also, be decided by the Committee of the Professor for justified scientific needs.

The doctorate students in duty at the Public Administrations can benefit from the study grant only on condition that they are on unpaid leave, for the course entire duration. In case of admission to the research doctorate with no study grant, or renounce to it, the concerned person who is on leave keeps the financial, security and retirement treatment he enjoys by the public administration in which the working relation is established. If, after obtaining the research doctorate, the working relation with public administration ceases due to the employee's will in the subsequent two years, the repayment of the received amount is due according to what stated above.

Duties of the doctorate students as per Min. Decree 630/2024

In addition to the duties provided for doctoral students contained in the University Regulations as regards Research Doctorates, as required by Ministerial Decree 630/2024, doctoral students who have been awarded scholarships pursuant to Ministerial Decree 630/2024 must undertake upon enrollment to:

- produce, at a frequency that will be specified by the Ministry, a report indicating the time commitment (broken down into months in the company, onsite and abroad) and a summary of the main activities carried out, also declaring that they comply with the principle of "not causing significant damage to the environment"; the reporting will be done through the appropriate online platform (<https://dottorati.mur.gov.it>) and using the forms therein;
- carry out the required mandatory study and research periods abroad and in the enterprise; failure to meet the minimum period in the enterprise and abroad will result in revocation of the scholarship;
- ensure compliance with the communication and information requirements of Article 34 of Regulation (EU) 2021/241, indicating in all documentation that the Program is funded under the NRP, making explicit reference to funding from the European Union and the NextGenerationEU initiative, displaying the logo of the European Union in the documentation, and provide adequate dissemination and promotion of the Program, including online, both web and social, in line with the provisions of the Communication Strategy of the NRRP;
- comply with the principle of not doing significant harm to environmental objectives, in accordance with Article 17 of Regulation (EU) 2020/852.

In addition to the provisions of the University Regulations as regards Research Doctorates, for doctoral students who have won scholarships under Min. Decree 630/2024, revocation of the scholarship is provided for in the following cases:

- realization of the doctoral course in a manner different from the project accepted for funding, where the necessary authorization has not been previously requested and subsequently granted by MUR;
- failure to carry out the minimum period of study and research in a company or abroad.

ART. 12 – AWARDING OF THE TITLE

The title of Research Doctor is awarded by the Rector and it is obtained upon successfully passing the final exam, at the completion of the course legal duration; the exam cannot be repeated. The University certifies its awarding and deals with the filing of the thesis in the National Libraries of Rome and Florence. The final thesis can be prepared also in a foreign language prior to authorization by the Professors' Committee.

ART. 13 – COMMISSIONS FOR THE AWARDING OF THE TITLE

The Selection Commissions for the awarding of the title of research doctor are appointed as per the Regulations of Doctorate of the University

ART. 14 – INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA TREATMENT

The processing of personal data provided by applicants, collected for the purposes identified in this Notice, is carried out in accordance with the provisions of EU Regulation 27.04.2016, N° 679 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR).

ART. 15 – PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROCEDURE
