**Uninettuno university:
open pole in Rabat**

The first technological pole of the International Telematic University Uninettuno, a Mediterranean university for distance training in five languages whose diplomas are recognised in Europe, will open on March 14 in Rabat. The opening ceremony - which will include a signing of an agreement between Morocco's government, represented by the professional training state secretary, Said Oulbacha, and Uninettuno, represented by its president and rector Maria Amata Garito - will be attended by Moroccan Prime Minister Driss Jettou and various ministers. The technological pole in Rabat, created at the state secretariat for professional training, is equipped with all technologies necessary to attend the distance courses and take part in the didactic activities through a video conference, and will represent a physical meeting point for exams and seminars. The first concrete step will be a computer literacy course for 10,000 students. Uninettuno (www.uninettunouniversity.net) has already signed agreements with universities in Egypt, Jordan and Tunisia where other technological poles will be opened.
